PARTNERS IN PRESERVATION

Our way of life and very country are the direct result of a 400 year sweep of history in the Historic Triangle. This land – with all of its splendor - has all had a role in shaping the history that lies within our region. It is this land that the Williamsburg Land Conservancy is trying to protect... forever.

The Williamsburg Land Conservancy is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit corporation that is dedicated to protecting and preserving significant natural, scenic, agricultural and historic land in the James and York Rivers watersheds. The Conservancy is proud to be the Colonial Williamsburg Foundation's (CWF) partner in preservation! Working together, the two organizations have been able to protect a gateway to history that will keep one of our region's major entry corridors forever green.

In 2006, CWF donated a conservation easement on a 230 acre parcel of land known as Carr's Hill to the Conservancy. The land extends along Route 132 to just below Queen's Creek. At the end of 2008, CWF donated another 82 acre conservation easement to the Conservancy on land located across Route 132 from the Carr's Hill property. The combined easements provide viewshed protection for a three-quarter mile segment of highway between Queens Creek and Route 60 Bypass Road.

Both of the easements contain mature deciduous forest, wetlands bordering Queen's Creek and its tributaries and have historic archaeological resources on their lands. Development could have taken place on these properties. But instead, CWF gave a gift to the community by permanently protecting the land.

In accepting both of these easements, the Conservancy took on a stewardship role that will go on into perpetuity. The Conservancy is responsible for monitoring all of their conservation easements to ensure that the terms of the Deed of Conservation Easement are upheld. Through their Land Stewardship program, the Conservancy visits each protected property regularly to evaluate the current state of the land and document their findings.

The Conservancy currently holds permanent conservation easements on more than 3,000 acres. This means that this land will never be significantly developed -- not in one or two generations, not in 10 or 20 generations...never.
